EXPLANATION OF SERVICES:

Basic professional services

Professional consultation with licensed personnel, which may include but is not limited to, expert advice on options to meet your needs, including essential services relating to disposition, drafting notices, planning scheduling of services, advising regarding possible government benefits. A basic professional fee is payable whenever we provide services to you.

Coordinating activities, rites and ceremonies

Co-ordination of all rites and ceremonies, before, during and after they have been provided, including services and supplies provided by us, as well as those provided by third party suppliers, such as flowers and death notices.

Documentation – permits, forms, etc.

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate for cremation, documentation necessary to ship the body out of the country. As part of this service, we will provide you with unlimited proof of death certificates; such certificates are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes, but sometimes a Provincial Death Certificate will be necessary and is available from the Office of the Registrar General.

Transport remains

Transportation of the remains from one place to another, for example the hospital to our premises, or from our premises to the cemetery or crematorium using a transfer vehicle, for distances not exceeding 40 km. A charge applies for each transportation request.

Additional charge for distances over 40 km from the funeral home will be charged at \$2.05 per kilometer one way per vehicle. These per kilometer fees are in addition to the basic vehicle usage fees listed below.

Basic preparation of remains (requires facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter)

The preparation of the body for placement into the casket, including bathing, dressing and the setting of facial features for identification or viewing without embalming.

Embalming of remains (in addition to basic preparation of remains)

Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. Our professional funeral directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and expected service needs.

An additional fee will be charged when the remains have been autopsied, if there has been any tissue, organ or bone donation, or where restoration is required.

Staff services for visitation (requires facilities and/or equipment for visitation)

Staff to coordinate and oversee the visitation (informal gathering) at our premises or at an off-site location.

EXPLANATION OF SERVICES (CONTINUED):

Staff services for ceremony (requires facilities and/or equipment for ceremony)

Staff to coordinate and oversee the ceremony, memorial or come-and-go celebration at our premises or at an off-site location for a period of up to two hours.

Facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter

Facilities used to prepare, embalm and/or shelter the body; this charge applies whenever the body is in our facility for any purpose.

Facilities and/or equipment for visitation (requires staff services for visitation)

Designated facilities at our funeral home used for public visitation and one hour of family visitation **or** the use of our equipment for public visitation and one hour of family visitation at an off-site location.

Facilities and/or equipment for ceremony (requires staff services for ceremony and/or burial)

Designated facilities at our funeral home used for the ceremony, memorial or come-and-go celebration **or** the use of our equipment for the ceremony or memorial service at an off-site location.

Clergy/Lead Car - used to lead the funeral procession and/or transport the clergy to/from church, funeral home, cemetery.

Funeral Coach – used to transport casket to cemetery or an off-site location.

Service/Utility Vehicle – used to transport deceased from place of death to the funeral home and used for general duties.

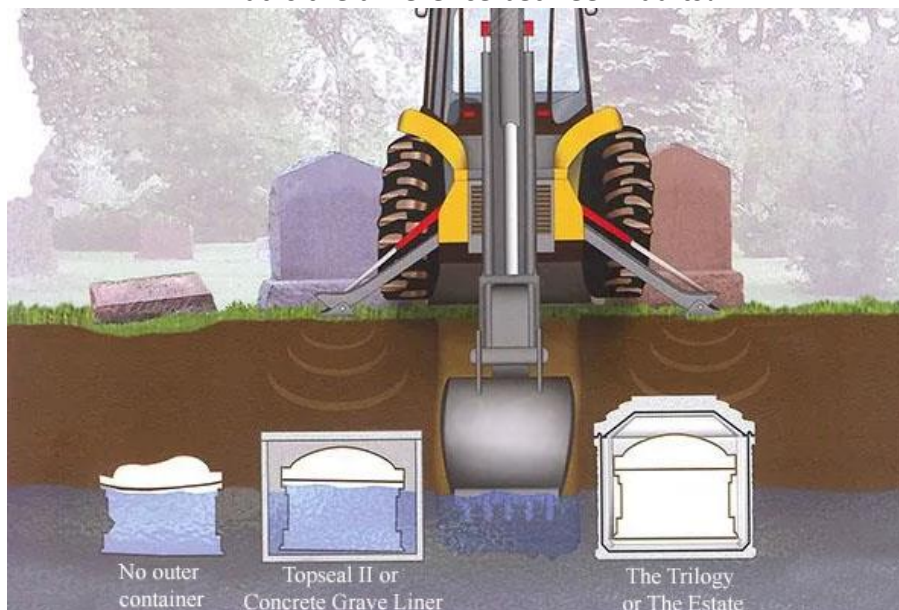

Harmonized Sales Tax (HST) at a rate of 13% is applicable to the Funeral Home fees, the merchandise and most cash disbursements and it will be added to the account for all applicable items.

Payment in full is due within 30 days from the date the contract is signed (the "Due Date"). Amounts outstanding after that date will bear interest at the rate of 2% per month (26.82% per annum calculated monthly and compounded annually, from the Due Date until paid in full).

Payment may be made via cheque, bank draft, e-transfer (info@englandfuneralhome.com), cash, debit or credit (most major credit cards accepted). **If the purchaser chooses to pay via credit card, a 2.4% credit card service fee will be applied to the amount paid.** There will be a charge of \$25.00 for any non-sufficient funds (NSF) cheques returned by the bank.

Financial assistance for funeral, burial or cremation services is available through various governmental agencies, to those who qualify.

Pre-payment in advance of need:

For services that are being arranged pre-need, we offer two funding options when prepaying services or supplies:

Trust: You pay for the services and supplies at today's price and we will place your money in a trust account, where it will accrue interest until the prepaid contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered). Pre-payment can be made via pre-authorized withdrawal from your bank account. Funds are held in the purchaser's name.

Insurance: You may purchase an insurance or annuity policy through us, where the proceeds of the insurance/annuity policy will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered. For single payments, payment may be made by pre-authorized withdrawal from your bank account. Time payment plans may be made via pre-authorized chequing. The policy is held in your name and assigned to the funeral home. Terms, conditions and cancellation policies are set by the Insurance Company.

Guarantee: When paid in full in accordance with the payment terms set out in the prepaid contract, the prepaid contract is guaranteed (excluding disbursements). The total payment(s) made plus interest/growth earned will be applied to the future price of the services and supplies. If the total payment(s) plus interest/growth earned are insufficient to cover the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies, we will absorb the difference as a loss. Any funds in excess of the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies will be returned or applied toward additional services, supplies and disbursements purchased at the time of need, as applicable. Conditions apply. Any changes to the prepaid contract *may* result in the prepaid contract being null and void and a new contract being executed with current pricing at the time changes are made. Invested funds plus accrued interest would be applied to the balance.
